New Homes For Alton Wildlife

To give our local wildlife a helping hand on the housing ladder the Town Council is providing a number of free home available for immediate occupation (with vacant possession)

The developments, which include commercial as well as residential dwellings are located in two sought after locations in the town within the urban backdrop of the Public Gardens and the waterside surroundings of King's Pond. The homes at Kings' Pond are available for Tawny Owls as well as homes of multiple occupancy for colony bats as well as spacious individual bat boxes for the single tenant.

The offering at the Public Gardens comprises of a multi-storey bug hotel, discrete hedgehog barns, a frog shelter, mouse house and bird, bat and bee boxes all in elevated positions with a sunny outlook over the town.

The accommodations have been made available courtesy of a grant of £641 from district councillor Richard Platt and are designed to help nature conservation by providing these facilities to assist our urban habitats. There is also evidence that the presence of wildlife in our open spaces can provide health and wellbeing benefits for the human visitor, providing an opportunity to connect with nature at a local level.

Naomi's Preserves will be there with her stall selling small batch jams and chutneys made using the freshest ingredients using traditional methods. Perfect for your walking and cycling picnic lunches.

The monthly Hampshire Farmers Market and Lions Craft Market will also be on in the High Street so do pop down and see what's on offer there.
