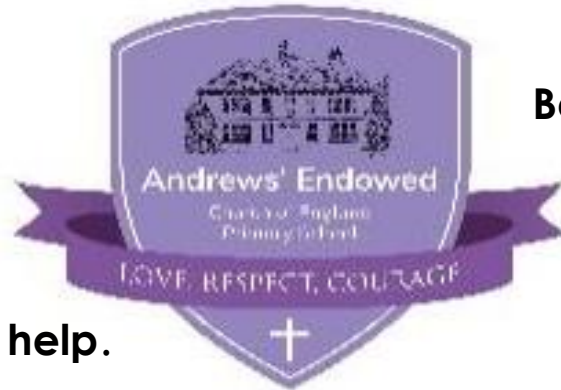
Show independence within their learning.
